Will my four year old kindergartner be eligible for transportation?

Resident students in 4K who live one or more miles from their attendance area school, are eligible for transportation. <http://www.cedarburg.k12.wi.us/programs/transportation.cfm>

Can my child be transported to and from a location other than the child’s home? In other words, will the district pick up and drop off four year old kindergartners at their family’s child care provider or preschool.

If a child’s daycare or childcare provider is located within the four year old kindergartner’s school attendance area and is located in an area eligible for transportation service (the daycare or childcare provider is one (1) or more miles from the school), the child is entitled to transportation to and from that location.

Revised condition: Location of the childcare provider must be within the same public elementary school attendance area in which the student resides (unless both the school district and bus company determine that another existing bus route could be used more efficiently) and the childcare provider is located in an area eligible for transportation service (one (1) or more miles from the school).

The following two examples apply to both morning and afternoon 4K sessions IF the daycare provider the parent/guardian selects is in their attendance area and is located in an area eligible for busing:

1. Parents can have their child picked up by bus and transported to school OR the parent can drive their child to the daycare location and then be transported by bus from the daycare location to school.
2. After school, a child can be transported home by bus OR be transported by bus to the daycare and then picked up by the parent.

NOTE: A ***Student Transportation Form*** must be completed to be eligible.

TRANSPORTATION STUDENT SAFETY REMINDERS

Sneak Peak / Bus Orientation:

On August 30, 2017, from 4:30-6:30, students and their parents will have the opportunity to go on a bus ride! During each school's annual kick-off (called Sneak Peak), a bus will be stationed in front of the school to orientate students to riding the bus, give them a chance to meet a bus driver and learn some quick and easy safety tips!

Transitions:

- Parent/guardian/caregiver should remain at the bus stop until the student is safely on/off the bus.
- Mid-Day Transitions: School staff will ensure students safely transition from the school building to the bus or from the bus to the school building.

Seating:

- 4K students will be seated in the front seats of the bus along with other 4K or 5K students.

Bus Expectations:

- Snacks and drinks are not allowed on the bus.
- Students are to remain seated in their seat until they arrive at their bus stop.

Bus Route Information:

All bus route information will be communicated with families via a postcard mailer from Riteway Bus on/before August 25, 2017.
