



Cedarburg High School Congratulates Perfect ACT Score Recipients

Less than one-half of a percent of students who take the ACT examination earn a perfect score of 36 points. This year, two Cedarburg High School students achieved this feat by acing each of the four assessment sections: English, Math, Reading, and Science.



The CHS students who achieved a perfect 36 ACT score this year are Jayne Phillips and Max Verhaalen.

The ACT is aligned to the ACT College and Career Readiness Standards and measures the core knowledge and skills addressed in high school and postsecondary instructional programs. The test itself was facilitated at Cedarburg High School on March 8, 2022.

The test includes more than two hours of question responses, which are spread out over the course of one school day. Their flawless performance on the ACT is indicative of superior educational achievement across the content areas.
