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Cedarburg School District Celebrates Success

CEDARBURG, WI - The Cedarburg School District is happy to share the results of our 2021-2022 School and District Report Cards. These report cards are compiled using a variety of data, including the state assessments from the previous school year, which were shared with families this past summer.

The Cedarburg School District ranked 3rd in the state out of Wisconsin's K-12 public school districts and earned the highest rating of *Significantly Exceeds Expectations* on the 2021-22 District Report Card. This rating is based on four priority area scores: achievement, growth, target group outcomes, and on-track to graduation.

The overall district score improved since the last report card in 2021-22, and we are incredibly proud that, for the second time, each of our five schools earned the rating of *Significantly Exceeds Expectations*. This performance is truly exceptional, and the achievement of ALL students continues to be a point of celebration.

“We are incredibly proud of all that our students and staff have accomplished, and this achievement recognizes the work of our entire 4K-12 system”, said Superintendent Dr. Clark. “The educators, administrators, and support staff of the Cedarburg School District continue to do everything possible to facilitate the highest levels of student achievement and post-secondary readiness. 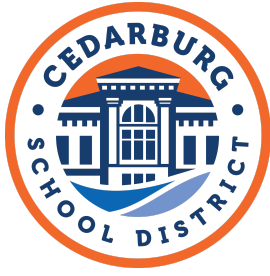
