Cedarburg AFS provides opportunities for hosting international teens 15-18 years old. Young ambassadors come from 90+ countries and are eager to share American family life. Your family will benefit by learning about another culture, understanding more about your own culture, leading to world understanding. You don't need to have a high school student or be a "traditional family" to host; all that is required to host is a separate bed for the student, 3 meals/day, and your love.
