Cedarburg is an historic, suburban community, 18 miles north of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The current population is 11,753. Cedarburg High School is a four-year comprehensive public high school and a member of the North Shore Conference. The Cedarburg School District encompasses portions of Grafton, Jackson, Mequon and West Bend. Cedarburg High School has 75 faculty members and four administrators. CHS is the only high school counseling department in Wisconsin that is ASCA RAMP certified.

School Honors

Cedarburg High School has been recognized by *U.S. News & World Report* on their annual list of "Best Schools" in the nation. CHS is ranked #4 in WI and #330 in the nation (top 2%).

Newsweek recognized Cedarburg High School as the #1 STEM school in WI and #157 in the nation.
