

MORGAN HERRICK

Athlete, Class of 2007



Morgan Herrick, a 3-sport varsity athlete, spent the majority of her playing time on the basketball court, achieving First-Team All-Conference status all four years at CHS and All-State honors her junior and senior years. Additionally, Morgan was named North Shore Conference Player of the Year for three years and was a member of the Wisconsin All-Star Team her senior year. Named the CHS Basketball team's most valuable player for 4 years and team captain for 3 years, Morgan helped her team reach the semi-finals of the Wisconsin Division 1 State Basketball Tournament her junior year. In her career at CHS, Morgan is currently the all-time leading scorer, 2nd in all-time rebounds, and 3rd in all-time assists and steals.


In volleyball, Morgan was a 4-year letter winner and team captain her senior year, leading her team to three North Shore Conference Championships. She achieved All-Conference status her junior and senior years and All-State Honorable Mention her junior year.

As a varsity softball player for 2 years, Morgan earned 2 letters and All-Conference Honors her freshman and sophomore years and helped her team win the North Shore Conference Championship her sophomore year.

Morgan continued playing basketball at Drake University and at the University of Chicago, where, in her senior year, she was UAA Conference Player of the Year, an All-Central Region First Team honoree, Player of the Year Central Region, and All-American First Team.

PAUL SIGLER

Athlete, Class of 1975



At CHS, Paul excelled in both football and wrestling. Paul played football all 4 years, and was selected All-Conference Honorable Mention in 1975. Wrestling, however, was Paul's dominant sport, boasting a 31-1 career record. A 4-year varsity wrestler and 4-year letter winner, Paul was team captain for 2 years and MVP for 2 years. After winning conference, regional, and sectional honors, Paul was also a two-time State qualifier. Paul became CHS's first State Champion wrestler in 1975, competing at 145 pounds.

Paul's accomplishments extended beyond the state level when, in 1974 and 1975, he was named to the USA Magazine High School All-American Team. He was further recognized in Sports Illustrated as one of the "Faces in the Crowd."

Paul received a full scholarship to UW Madison, where he was a letter winner in 1976, 1977, and 1979. Paul graduated with a degree in education and served in the Oak Creek School District as a teacher and administrator for 23 years.

JERRY "TUFFY" WOLTER

Athlete, Class of 1961



Jerry "Tuffy" Wolter was a 3-sport participant at CHS. In track, Jerry lettered his senior year and set a school record for the 880 race. In football, Jerry lettered 2 years, was Team Captain and named Team MVP his senior year. Conference-wide football honors include being named by unanimous decision to First Team All Braveland Conference as a Center, and a State Honorable Mention honoree. Jerry's defensive accomplishments include 1 interception for a touchdown, 2 safeties, and 4 blocked punts. In basketball, Jerry was similarly impressive, lettering 2 years and being both Team Captain and Team MVP his senior year. In the Braveland Conference, Jerry was the leading scorer and set a CHS scoring record for most points in a season.

After graduation Jerry served his country in the United States Marine Corps Air Wing in aircraft maintenance and is a Vietnam veteran. During his time in the Marine Corps, Jerry had the opportunity to continue his love for basketball by playing on the 9th Marine Headquarters Team.
