

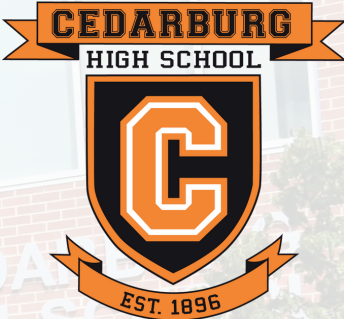

Community & School Facts

Cedarburg is a historic, suburban community 18 miles north of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The current population is 13,011. Cedarburg High School is a four-year comprehensive public high school and a member of the North Shore Conference. The Cedarburg School District encompasses portions of Grafton, Jackson, Mequon, and West Bend. Cedarburg High School has 72 faculty members and four administrators. CHS is one of three Wisconsin high school counseling departments that are ASCA RAMP certified.

SCHOOL HONORS



Recognized as a Department of Education National Blue Ribbon School, Cedarburg High School is ranked on Niche and U.S. News & World Report annual lists of “Best Schools” in the nation for the eleventh year in a row. In 2025, USN ranked CHS #4 in WI and #329 in the national rankings, placing CHS in the top 1% in the nation and #6 in the state for college readiness.

Newsweek recognized CHS as the #1 STEM school in WI and #157 nationally. The National Center for Women in Technology awarded 28 students with the 2025 NCWIT Award - the most in WI for the sixth year in a row. In addition, CHS has a World Champion Coding Club and an Award-winning Robotics Team.

CHS earned a five-star rating, "Significantly Exceeds Expectations", on the DPI School Report Card for 2023-24.

The Class of 2024 is #1 in the metro area on the statewide ACT and #2 in Wisconsin.

Grading Scale

GPA is based on semester grades earned in grades 9-12. Advanced Placement courses, and Calculus III receive an additional point weight in GPA calculations. CHS is on a 4.0 GPA scale. Class rank was eliminated by district policy in 2011.
