Webster First Lego League is open to all 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. The team size for First Lego League is limited to 10 students. This year we will have up to 6 teams. All students are encouraged to join. You do not need to know about Lego or robotics to have fun!

## Is there a participation fee?

There is a participation fee. The fee has varied in previous seasons. The fee for this season will be \$50 per student. This fee will cover a team shirt and supplies for this year's competition. Some fundraising may be needed. This fee can be paid via skyward fee management - First Lego League Robotics.

## When do we meet?

Our Informational meeting with parents will be held after school in the LGI on Monday, Sept. 8th at 3:00. Student practices will begin Thursday, Sept. 11th. Practices will then meet 3 days during the week after school. Meeting times are scheduled 3:00-4:45 Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday. Some extra meeting time might need to be added to complete the tasks. The team will attend a minimum of 1 Regional Qualifying competition in November/December. This is an all day event on a Saturday or Sunday where students are expected to be in attendance for the entirety. Students will showcase their challenge, robot and meet other students from Southeast Wisconsin. This competition will be announced when it is officially scheduled.

## Fundraising

The team will have to do some fundraising this year to help offset the cost of the season. Our first Fundraiser will be presenting robot and project progress at the Robotics Night at Wayne's Drive in October. Students will present their robot under the big top. There will be more information sent out closer to the date.


